

Application to Lift Breeding Restrictions



- When a dog whose registration is endorsed with a breeding restriction is transferred to new ownership, the endorsement will be maintained.
- The new owner can apply to lift the endorsement.
- Any endorsement may only be lifted with the writing permission of the endorser.
- This completed and signed application form should be forwarded to Canine Registry in application to lift the endorsement.
- The application fee is R200.
